Saving Money is Easy: December

Question 1:

You have \$14.54 in your credit union account. Last week you made a deposit of \$6.11 and today you made a deposit of \$7.85. How much do you have saved?

Apswer 1:

\$14.54 6.11 <u>+ 7.85</u> \$28.50 You have \$28.50 saved. Great job!

Question 2:

You've been busy! You walked Mrs. Johnson's dog 13 times in the past 2 weeks. Each time you walk the dog, Mrs. Johnson pays you 75ϕ . How much money have you made?

Answer 2:

75¢ is \$0.75 in decimal form.

\$0.75 <u>x 13</u> \$9.75 You have made \$9.75.

Question 3:

Your credit union just paid interest! You had \$101.50 in your account, and got a 2% dividend. How much interest did you earn?

Answer 3:

Multiply 2% by the amount of money in your account! 2% in decimal for is .02.

\$101.50	
<u>x .02</u>	
\$2.03	You earned \$2.03 in interest!
